Notice is hereby given that on November 25th, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. the Elbert County Board of County Commissioners will hold a public meeting, during which the board will engage in an Executive Session pursuant to C.R.S. 24-6-402(4)(b) to conference with the County attorney and to discuss legal matters or consultation with legal counsel concerning disputes that are the subject of pending or imminent court proceedings or matters that are privileged or confidential between attorney and client issues involving, and/or determining positions relative to matters that may be subject to negotiations, developing strategy for negotiations; and/or instructing negotiators pursuant to C.R.S. 24-6-402(4)(e). The executive session is for legal advice on specific questions related to litigation pending in Elbert County District Court between the Elbert County Board of County Commissioners and the Elbert County Sheriff's Office, case no. 2024CV30091. The Board shall take no formal action in the executive session in contravention of C.R.S. 24-6-402(4), nor will the board engage in any adoption of any proposed policy, position, resolution, rule, or regulation during the executive session. At the conclusion of the executive session, the board will come out of the executive session and make any motions, take any action, or vote in an open public session upon the resumption of a public meeting related to executive session discussion during the public portion of such meeting.
